2024 sector-wide data for Ontario's nonprofit sector now available

Ontario Nonprofit Network (ONN) has <u>launched results</u> from their annual state of the sector survey. This year's data reveals that the nonprofit sector is experiencing stagnant and declining financial resources amidst climbing demand. Against all odds, nonprofits remain steadfast in their determination and hopeful that at some point, they will be adequately resourced to fulfill



their missions. This duality of hope and despair is reflected in the fact that this year 45 per cent of survey respondents reported feeling overwhelmed, and 41 per cent reported feeling optimistic at this current moment. ONN has prepared a number of resources related to the survey results that are available <u>on their website</u>, and they will be hosting a <u>free webinar</u> on November 6 to highlight the many ways nonprofits can utilize the data in their advocacy efforts.

Against all odds, nonprofits remain steadfast in their determination and are hopeful that at some point, they will be adequately resourced to fulfill their missions. This duality of hope and despair is reflected in the fact that this year 45% of survey respondents reported feeling overwhelmed, and 41% reported feeling optimistic at this current moment.

A few data highlights:

- 39% of respondents assessed themselves at significant risk (ranked at a 5 or above) for not existing in the next three years.
- 83% of respondents saw an increase in demand for programs and services, a seven percent increase over 2023.
- 54% of respondents reported stagnant and declining revenue while 84 per cent reported increase in expenses.
- 31% of respondents reported using their reserve funds, almost mirroring pandemic-era levels.
